  - Safer Act – Working on the 5<sup>th</sup> request.
  - I re-submitted an AFG-S grant last week for just over \$37,000 for supplies used for the COVID-19 event.
  - Will be submitting for reimbursement on COVID supplies from the CARE Act.
  - We did receive a 50/50 matching grant from SDAO for Security to purchase more camera's to be installed in the building next door.
