Minutes of the Last Meetings:


Minutes from the December 10, 2018, Board meeting were reviewed.

Phillips – aye Giberson – aye Peasley – aye VanDeGrift – aye Tavera - aye




Motion carried 5 ayes, zero nays.

- Chief Jensen submitted a SDAO Grant for video surveillance for a cost of \$4385.00. This is a 50/50 grant and the district received notice that we had be awarded. We have until June of 2019 to have it completed. Working on getting the equipment ordered.
- 4. The Sub-Station (Station 41) is about 95% complete with plans to move the Engine and Suburban in by the end of the month.
- 5. We have ordered the Structure Helmet's and they should be in by the end of the month.
- 6. The replacing the propane line from the tank to the building and relocating the propane tank has been completed.
- Working on the Homeland Security Grant for new Mobile Tri-band Radios. Grant Application is due on January 21, 2019. Working with Dundee Fire and Yamhill PD as a joint grant and Murray Paolo is helping to write that grant.


