  - b. We have finalized the build for the new Brush Rig. – Still on schedule for a June 2021 completion date. Finalized the funding piece and have ordered the radios.
  - c. We are currently working with the vendor to get the correct 4” hose. – The correct Hose is here and marked. Will be loaded on the new engines this Thursday Evening.
  
3. Grants
  - a. Safer Act –
  - c. The new AFG application period has opened. Working on that application with the plan of applying for, 22 sets of Turnouts, 22 additional SCBA face masks, 9 Triband mobile radios and 20 pagers. – This has been submitted.
  - e. We did receive a 50/50 matching grant from SDAO for Security to purchase more camera’s to be installed in the building next door. Working on.
  - f. Will be working with Murray Paolo on the Homeland Security Grant for Radios. – This grant has been submitted.
  - g. Looking at other Grants as they become available. – Fire House Subs opens on 4-13-2021
  
4. We are still waiting on reimbursement from the State for the Conflagration Fires in the amount of about \$130,000.000. – We received about \$75,000 from the Holiday Fire on Friday. Still waiting on California. (about \$52,000)
