- 4. Met with ISO to review the re rating of the Fire District, once the new Tender is inservice, we will need to do some re-arranging of equipment. If we move E-41 to the Station 41 (sub) along with E-43, ISO will re-rate that area from a 10 to an 8-B. In talking with the local insurance company, a \$500,000 home could see their yearly Fire insurance decrease by as much as \$1500 a year. Looking at this summer of being completed with the total ISO rating and could be looking at moving the whole district to one rating of a 4, which is current what we are at in the city.
